Monday, April 8, 2024 – 6:30 PM Poultney Town Hall

Jeff King called the meeting to order and led those present in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Selectmen present included: Jeff King, Sheryl Porrier, Alan-Glen Burnell, and Mark Teetor. Others present included Paul A. Donaldson, Joel Roberts, Carol Stierle and Michelle McCarron. Attending via Zoom members included Janice B. Edwards, Karen Atwood and Mary Sue Reed.

Adoption of the Agenda: Alan-Glen Burnell made a motion to adopt the Agenda. Mark Teetor seconded the motion. Motion passed with all in favor.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Sheryl Porrier made a motion to approve the minutes of 3-25-24. Mark Teetor seconded the motion. Motion passed with all in favor.

<u>Road Report:</u> Joel Roberts reported the following:

-The crew has started storm cleanup of trees; this will be for the next couple of weeks.

-They have been spot grading roads for the last couple of weeks.

-There is an air leak in one of the trucks they will see if they can repair in-house, otherwise the truck will need to go to Westminster.
