3) The Town purchased a 40 by 14 ft steel bridge with a load capacity of 40 tons to replace the old logging truck bridge for Ames Hollow at a cost of \$ 21,000. The abutment and wing wall construction specifications will be delivered next week. The abutment and wing wall construction is a FEMA project.

4) The Town will purchase three new narrow band radios for the Highway Department by the end of June. The radios will be paid for through a Vermont Emergency Management grant.

5) Copies of Rosenthal's letter to Terry Williams regarding truck traffic and weight limits were distributed.

6) Chloride will be ordered and applied by the end of June.

Town Manager's Report:
