Chairman Jeff King called the meeting to order. Selectmen present included: Frank Fressie, Corey Davenport, Tom Coloutti, Terry Williams. Others present included: Paul A. Donaldson, Town Manager, Ron Kelley, Road Foreman, Betsy Sinnoot, Bianca Zanella, and Bob Allen, President of Green Mountain College.

<u>Adoption of the Agenda:</u> Pledge of Allegiance. Terry Williams made a motion to adopt the agenda. Corey Davenport seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Frank Fressie made a motion to approve the minutes of 1/9/2017 and 1/12/2017. Terry Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Public Comments and Concerns:

Bob Allen, President of Green Mountain College, requested support of the Selectboard in the college's refinance of their debt obligations with the USDA for 18M dollars, at a rate of 3.375% compared to its current rate of 6.62%. The college wants to do it by the end of June. Paul Donaldson advised Mr. Allen to seek support from the Village Board of Trustees as well. The college, on the reported advise of the USDA, will transfer all its properties on campus to an affiliated LLC. Discussion followed, and the board unanimously agreed to support the college in its endeavors.

Bianca Zanella reported that the GMC 20/20 project had a February 9 meeting, and that Stone Valley Arts had a January 27, 5:30PM meeting.

Road Report:

Ron Kelley reported the following:

- 1. Ferncliff Road wall is complete, for a cost under \$10,000.00 for labor and materials.
- 2. The new truck is now in service for winter storms since it no longer has to haul blocks for the Ferncliff retaining wall.
- 3. Ron questioned whether the person who hit the vet clinic was insured as there was damage to several signs. Paul Donaldson advised he would ask Ed Hunter. Tom Coloutti relayed his witnessing of the accident.
- 4. Paul and Ron met with the Rutland Planning Commission to review culvert inventory and identify possible road improvements for the next round of grant applications.
- 5. Town of Wells road crew wishes to share expense of a crusher to clean up Upper Road where Royal Harrison had duped slate waste. Ron does not think it would be cost-effective.
- 6. Discussion followed regarding a request to upgrade Dayton Road.
