Meeting Minutes

Poultney Board of Selectmen

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Jeff King called the meeting to order. Selectmen present included: Jeff King, Frank Fressie, Tom Coloutti, Terry Williams and George Miller. Others present included Paul A. Donaldson, Town Manager, Neisja Crawford, Secretary / Bookkeeper.

<u>Adoption of the Agenda</u>: Tom Coloutti made a motion to adopt the agenda. Terry Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: George Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of 6/26/17. Terry Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried

Road Report:

Paul Donaldson for Ron Kelly, who was off for bereavement of the death of his motherin-law, reported the following:

- grading and filling in potholes
- employees have been using vacation

Town Managers Report:

- Paul Donaldson: talked with Brian Sanderson; bridges are the Town's responsibility, except, Class I state municipal roads and bridges over railroad tracks (140 bridge is part Village and Town, the guard rail is on the town side)
- Tax Payment agreements

Paul Donaldson: delinquent property owner is asking for a payment arrangement-I'm telling people, I'm reluctant to agree to any tax payment plan, until I discuss with the Select Board

Tom Coloutti: first ask them if they've gone to the bank to request a line of credit Paul Donaldson: think we should try to work with some people Terry Williams: what you do for one, you have to do for all Paul Donaldson: yes, but with any arrangement, must pay current taxes when due George Miller: how far back are taxes delinquent? Tom Coloutti: then everyone will want to make a payment plan Terry Williams: if you're going to do we must have a contract Jeff King: if they redeem from tax sale, then they're ahead Frank Fressie: hate to see us go back to where we were Paul Donaldson: payment plan would have to pay current at the same time Tom Coloutti: whatever we do, we have to do for others Terry Williams: what percentage of people that live in Poultney are delinquent? Paul Donaldson: look at report Jeff King: I'm opposed to any payment plan right now George Miller: ok if pay now and pay on previous year Paul Donaldson: concerned if no one bids at tax sale Terry Williams: Poultney has no affordable housing- think about getting local guys to fix up for town, then sale Paul Donaldson: I'm going to tell this lady no, and stay the course of the plan Frank Fressie: maybe put a letter in the tax bill explaining the Town's plan -are there any other people in a similar situation, that really can't pay? Paul Donaldson: there are several people in that situation Paul Donaldson: I'm trying to get an exemption for the Amish Terry Williams: New York gives it to them

 Caterer Liquor License (Taps Tavern), event 7-22-17 Stone Valley Arts Serena from Taps Tavern is trying to get a one day liquor license, for this instance Frank Fressie: Is there such thing as a one day license? Paul Donaldson: yes, for special event

-Green Mountain College has a catering license, do you want Betsy to give liquor license carte blanche

Jeff King: no, the Select Board needs to approve each license
