Poultney Board of Selectmen Monday, January 22, 2018 – 6:30 PM Poultney Town Hall

Town Managers Report:

Paul Donaldson reported the following:

- Tax Sales
 - Letters have gone out and responses have been coming in, collection of delinquents have been increasing.
 - Paul Donaldson waiting to to clarify with Carroll, Boe & Pell, if the Town can switch from 15% of delinquent tax principal collection fee, to a more attractive, hourly rate basis, for post statutory tax sale services, of properties that do not sale

• General Budget

Proposed budgets have been circulated to the board. Much discussion regarding trimming the budget and whether it can be accomplished by visiting some yearly allocations so as to put less of a strain on operating expenses of the town. Terry Williams questioned the ongoing allocation to the Lake Saint Catherine Association and the effectiveness of efforts to eradicate milfoil from the lake. Tom Coloutti mentioned that lake front properties contribute much to the tax base of the Town. Discussion regarding the transparency of the budgets and revenue sources for the Poultney Rescue

Squad. Discussion regarding the allocation to the Historical Society and the past two year's town reports of fixing windows in the historic buildings. Discussion regarding the need to fix windows in the Town Office. Increases in insurances have also affected budgeting

Highway Budget

Paul Donaldson has proposed a 2% increase in wages to be more in line with the Cost of Living Increase. Discussion regarding moving wage increases to a merit-based system, with quarterly reviews. Increases in insurances also reflected in proposed budget.

Library Budget

Trustees have proposed a 2% wage increase across the board, increases in building maintenance, insurance premiums

• Fire Department Budget

Chief Kerber has proposed to request the allocation the same as it was last fiscal year. He does want to see an increase in the Equipment Fund allocation as the board had agreed to in the past.
