Jeff King called the meeting to order. Selectmen present included: Jeff King, Terry Williams, George Miller, Carol Bunce, and Kim Rupe. Others present included Paul A. Donaldson, Town Manager, Ron Kelley, Highway Foreman, and Lieutenant Jim Bennick of the Rutland County Sheriff Department.

Road Report:

Ron Kelley reported that:

- The crew has been plowing and salting/sanding as needed, and making repairs as needed.
- East Road had some very bad ruts, and Ron Kelley has graded the road in the hopes that the road will settle back down before it freezes.
- They will grade portions of Hampshire Hollow Road, and Dayton Road next.
- We applied for a Grants-In-Aid for the York Street Extension culvert replacement.
- Ron would like to try some more Tenzar grid for road repairs, we used it on Finel Hollow and it worked very well
- We continue to meet with FEMA on our road damages.
- The crew purchased bullet-proof plexi glass for the excavator to cover the window so that we can start to use the brush cutter head.
- The crew broke up frozen chunks of sand in the sand shed.

Town Managers Report:

Paul Donaldson reported the following:

Poultney Comes Together meeting at 6:00 P.M. on January 15, 2020 at PHS.

- The board needs to adopt the 2019 Vermont Roads and Bridge Standards. Discussion followed. Terry Williams made a motion to adopt the standards. George Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried with all in favor.
- Discussion with Lieutenant Bennick re: rate increase. He stated that the department has 10 contract towns it provides services to. Profit margins are very low. Terry Williams asked how often the incident reports are posted online. Lieutenant Bennick stated that they need to be reviewed by a Sargent before posting and this sometimes creates a backlog. Discussion of if the town cuts the hours per week, will the hourly rate be the same. Discussion on whether the RCSD would use an office if we set one up for the Constable. Discussion of fingerprint machines and the costs to maintain and service the same. Lieutenant Bennick will report back once he poses some of these questions to the Sheriff.
- He continues to have discussions with folks at State of Vermont re: the D&H Rail Trail
 Trestle bridge.
- We are trying to schedule interviews for the Economic Developer Position.
